

Appendix 5.2 Skinnamarink

Words of traditional song (many versions)	Actions
<i>Skinnyrinky –dink-y-dink</i>	Roll hands one side/ one way
<i>Skinnyrinky-doo</i>	Roll hands on the other side/ other way
<i>I</i>	Point to self
<i>love</i>	Make a heart shape with hands
<i>You. (Repeat so far)</i>	Point to someone else.
<i>I love you in the morning</i>	Wave hands to the East (interesting in Foundation)
<i>And in the afternoon</i>	Wave hands to the west
<i>I I love you in the evening underneath the moon</i>	Point to the moon in the sky then lay your head on your “pillow hands”
<i>Skinnyrinky –dink-y-dink</i>	Roll hands one side/ one way
<i>Skinnyrinky-y-doo</i>	Roll hands on the other side/ other way
<i>I</i>	Point to self
<i>love</i>	Make a heart shape with hands
<i>You. (finish with a grand gesture e.g. boop boop ee-doo)</i>	Fling open arms in the air.
