The cobbler asks any of the students...

*Do you have my shoe?*



so so mi mi so

The cobbler responds singing:

*I don't have your shoe.*



Or Yes I have you shoe, and they change position, and the game continues.

#### Activities:

-Play the *beat* with little plastic hammers (two crotchet beats to the bar)

-Play the *rhythm* (play the words)

-At a sign by the teacher, change/ alternate throughout the song from beat to rhythm (words). A flashcard is useful for this purpose, with a picture of *beat* on one side and picture of *words* on the other.
